<sup>1</sup> Risk should be reduced as low as reasonably practicable. NB. If risks remain significant even with existing control measures then further control measures MUST be identified and implemented.

<sup>2</sup> If a risk of significant loss or injury (i.e. any incident that would result in over 3 days lost time, or a major injury or a reportable near-miss or which could lead to a financial loss greater than £) still exists when all "reasonably practicable" control measures have been implemented then the risk is NOT tolerable and the activity should be ceased. Further advice should be sought from the County's Health and Safety Team.
